



## SCHOOL DRESS CODE POLICY

**MAY 2013**

**(Checked Summer 2015)**

**Students are expected to be neat, tidy and dressed for learning at all times. Please read and follow the dress code.**

**The following items must be worn at school every day:**

- ✓ A Worle Community School Blazer to be worn at all times (Only to be removed at the discretion of a member of staff).
- ✓ A white, collared shirt with the top button done up.
- ✓ Plain black tailored trousers, worn on the waist.
- ✓ (Or, optional for girls - Plain black, tailored, knee length skirt).
- ✓ Plain black, flat, polishable closed shoes.
- ✓ A plain black (no logo) V neck jumper (optional) worn under the WCS blazer
- ✓ A WCS tie (Coloured with the relevant House stripe) to be worn at navel/waist length with the knot covering the top button.
- ✓ Hair colour must be natural – length of hair must be at least a Grade 3.

If worn, due to religious reasons:

- ✓ Plain black, navy or white head scarf.

**The following items must be brought and worn to Dance and PE lessons (PE staff will give additional guidance during the school year):**

Plain black short or long sleeved t-shirt

Plain black jogging bottoms or shorts

### PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL UNIFORM AND KIT IS NAMED

#### Make-up including nail varnish and jewellery:

- ✓ Years 7, 8 & 9 – make-up and nail varnish are not allowed.
- ✓ Years 10 & 11 – minimal, natural look make-up and nail varnish only.
- ✓ The only jewellery allowed is a maximum of two small earring studs per ear.

#### Please note the following:

- ✓ Trousers and skirts must not reveal any underwear and should be worn on the waist.
- ✓ Leggings, legging style or skinny fit trousers, or any style of jeans are not allowed.
- ✓ No trainers to be worn to assembly, in mentor or lesson time.
- ✓ Hooded jumpers or hooded sweatshirts are not allowed – the only exception is the school PE hooded top worn only in PE lessons. Hoodies will be confiscated and returned at the end of the school day.
- ✓ No denim clothing is to be worn.
- ✓ Coats can only be worn to and from school and whilst moving externally between lessons.
- ✓ All facial piercings are banned. If seen they will be confiscated by staff and returned at the end of the school day.
- ✓ Ear plugs, tunnels and stretchers are not allowed to be worn and will be confiscated and returned at the end of the school day.
- ✓ Tattoos must not be visible.
- ✓ Bangles are not allowed.

**Any member of staff can ask a student to abide by the School Dress Code.**

**Where a student does not follow the School Dress Code the school reserves the right to withdraw the student from circulation. In some circumstances a student may be sent home.**

**In all cases, the Head Teacher's decision is final.**
